Happy New Year to everyone. BVSC wishes you a full year of good health and prosperity. May the Blessing of Heaven be with you as we go through the New Year.

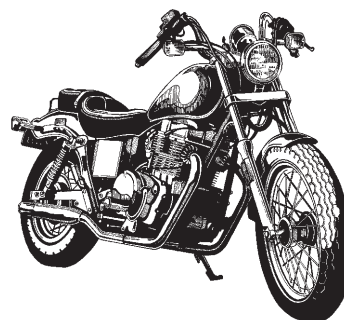
