Arabia Greeters

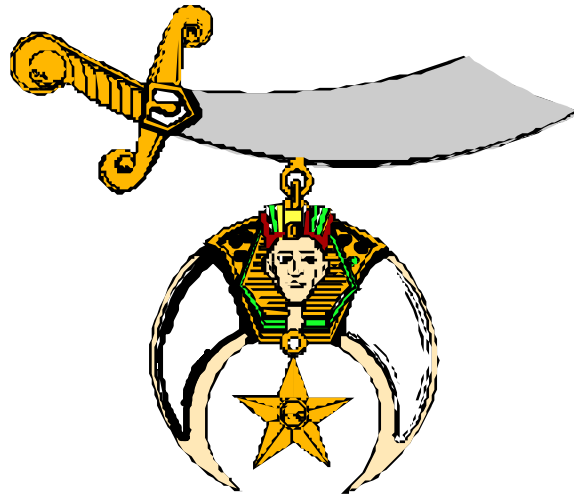
As our name (Greeters) implies, our main function is to greet at Shrine functions and other events at the Shrine Center as requested.

It was a hot day in July of 2003, in a quiet, unassuming neighborhood, an explosion broke the silence. An electrical transformer blew up and the power surge destroyed the televisions and electrical equipment in the nearby house. Instantaneously, a young man screamed out in pain. Most people would run away from such a scenario, but not Doug Vance, Past Master, Garden Oaks Lodge # 1306 and his father, Jack Vance, also Past Master of Garden Oaks Lodge #1306.

Mickey, the neighbor's son had been cleaning the pool using a telescopic rod. On lifting the rod, Mickey accidentally bumped the electrical wire overhead. The power surge electrocuted Mickey to the point that his swimming trunks were melted onto his skin. The electricity traveled down the pole, through Mickey and shot out through his calf. Mickey was transferred to The Shriner's Burn Hospital in Galveston, Texas. Mickey was in serious condition. He sustained third degree burns over 30% of his body and second degree burns over 50% of his body. The prognosis was poor.

In the face of a long, painful and arduous recovery, Mickey remained a valiant warrior. He underwent numerous skin grafts and was fitted with a compression suit. Mickey would not give up the fight.

Mike Gentry went on to graduate from high school, is now married and the happy couple is expecting a baby boy. He and his wife plan to name the baby, Dillon Vance Gentry, in honor of his neighboring hero, Doug Vance. The accident and Mickey's recovery has

bonded the Vance and Gentry families.

Michael Gentry is one of the hosts of "Fore" the Children, a Charity Golf Tournament benefiting the Shriner's Hospital in Galveston. He would like to give back to the Shiner's so that other children can have the same opportunity to receive the life saving procedures that saved his own life.

In 2011 this tournament successfully gave \$16,688.00 to the Shriner's Hospital Galveston. This tournament was held again on September 12, 2012 at Cypress Lakes Golf Course, the final numbers are not in yet but as of today the expected check will be over \$26,000.00 again for the Shriner's Hospital in Galveston. Michael is proud to be able to be one of the sponsors of this benefit for the hospital and hopes he can continue supporting our Shriner Children. There were several Nobles from Arabia at the Golf Tournament supporting Michael and his wonderful cause, Claude Eichenour, Randy Carter, Lloyd Parrent, Carl Chandler, Charlie Schancez and Casey York. Next year we need more Nobles to schedule this event on their calendars and try to attend this function, supporting Michael and his great cause.
